- **Internet Banking via your own online banking**

Payment can be made directly to our bank account. Please contact us for details.

- **EFTPOS/Credit cards**

Credit Card payments can be made in person at the Secondary Reception, over the phone, or on Parent Lounge on Schoolbox.

- **Cash and Cheques**

Please proceed to Secondary Reception if you wish to pay via cash or cheque. For large fee payments, it is the preference of the College that you pay via Parent Lounge on Schoolbox or directly to our bank account, so that large amounts of cash are not held on College premises.

INSTALMENTS

- **Direct Debits**

This is an arrangement where parents give the College permission to withdraw regular payments directly from their bank account. In 2024, we are offering weekly or fortnightly deductions on Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, as well as monthly on the 10th or 25th of each month.
